Sister Eileen was an educator in New Jersey. She served as a teacher in Immaculate Conception High School, Montclair; St. Mary High School and St. Aloysius High School, Jersey City; and the Academy of the Sacred Heart, Hoboken. She was a volunteer in Caritas Academy and in St. Aloysius Convent both in Jersey City. She was also very active in activities related to the CROP walk and with the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse. She retired to Saint Anne Villa, Convent Station, NJ in 2010 where she resided until her death.

She is survived by the Sisters of Charity; her sister Mary Lou Davis, Gilbert, AZ, nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews. She was predeceased by her parents, her sister Jeanne, and her nephews, Donald and Philip Tate.
