She was Admitting Clerk at St. Joseph Hospital & Medical Center, Paterson. After that, she worked in the Treasurer's Office, St. Elizabeth Convent, Convent Station. She was first Dean of Students and then the Attendance Person at the Academy of Saint Elizabeth, Convent Station. In 2015, she retired to Saint Anne Villa, Convent Station.
