Sister Helen Gregory served as librarian at Hudson Catholic Regional High School, Jersey City. She was an assistant coordinator and then coordinator at Visiting Homemakers, Jersey City. She retired to Saint Anne Villa, Convent Station in 1998 where she resided until her death.

Sister Helen Gregory was predeceased by her parents and her sisters, Sally and Cecile. She is survived by the Sisters of Charity; her brother, Rev. George Cotter, MM, her cousin, Thomas Kearny, her brother in law John Flemming, and many nieces and nephews and grand-nieces and nephews.
