We are pleased to announce the availability of #ProjectImpact Mini Grants to support new or existing service projects that address any of the following: the environment, human trafficking, poverty, migrants and refugees, peace and nonviolence, racism, women's rights.

Deadlines: For consideration in the fall, applications are due by **November 15, 2019**. If you would like your application considered in the spring, we must have your application by **March 15, 2019**. Applications will be reviewed and grants awarded within thirty days of the application deadline. **All projects must be completed within six months of receipt of grants funds.**

Awards: Applicants can apply for a mini grant of up to \$300

Eligibility: Youth ages 13-18 years old

Project Criteria: You can use your funds for just about anything – to purchase supplies for a new or existing project, to provide food or incentives to get participants involved in a worthy cause, to design or print materials to educate your local community on an important issue*. Surprise us!

*You must have an adult mentor who is willing to support your project.
