



### **The Mother Xavier Peace, Justice and Ecological Integrity Award**

-This award, initiated in the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary year of Mother Xavier's death, honors a Sister of Charity of Saint Elizabeth, Seton Associate, partner in mission who exemplifies the "conviction that a life of charity requires a faith that does justice, (*Toward Boundless Charity*, C20). The recipient demonstrates a notable commitment to the values of peace, justice and ecological integrity and the Vincentian focus on systemic change of unjust structures.

-A \$300 donation will be made to an organization of the recipient's choice in her/his name. Some other suitable token will also be given to the recipient.

-The award will be presented at the Fall Congregation Day or other suitable occasion.

-The Peace, Justice and Ecological Integrity Committee will chose the recipient from nominees that will be solicited from Sisters and Seton Associates.
