Sister Joan was an Educator in New Jersey. She served as a teacher at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament, East Orange; teacher and Principal in St. Joseph School, Echo Lake, West Milford; Sacred Heart School, Dover; Administrative Assistant to the pastor and then became Director of Religious Education at St. Therese, School, Succasunna. She was a Manager of the Development Office, Maurice Brick Residence, Dover. She was Director of Activities at Saint Anne Villa, Convent Station and P/T Food Service Coordinator at Xavier Center, Convent Station. She moved to Saint Anne Villa, Convent Station in 2015 where she resided until her death.
