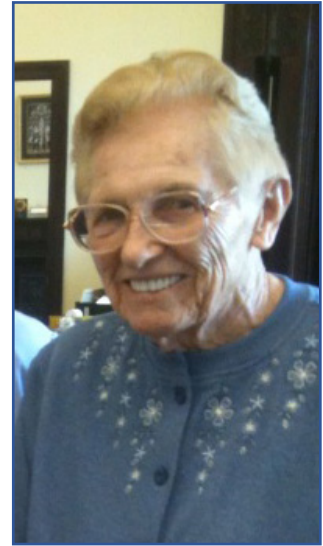


SISTER PAULA BLUE, SC

Sister Paula graduated from the College of St. Elizabeth, Convent Station, N.J. with a B.S. degree in education and from Barry University, Miami, FL, with an M.S. degree in Elementary Education. Sister Paula embodied the spirit of Charity. She was loved by her family, her friends, the Sisters of Charity of Saint Elizabeth as well as all with whom she ministered.

She is survived by the Sisters of Charity; she was predeceased by her parents, John A. and Josephine (Sak) Blue. Surviving is her brother John A.
